The deadline to turn in the registration form is October 4, 2023. PUMPKINS will need to be placed in Specific Locations. Upon Arrival and before unloading, please check in with Michele or Katelyn.

Pumpkins will be displayed from Monday, October 21st, through Saturday, October 26th. However,
